INSTRUCTIONS TO ACCOMPANY THE CONFIDENTIAL NOMINATION FORM

The person being nominated should have given outstanding voluntary service to the people of Haslemere, Hindhead or surrounding villages over several years; preferably this will have covered more than one organisation.

The awards are for individuals, not groups. There have been cases though when a husband and wife who have each given exemplary service, or two friends who have undertaken the same service together over many years, are sometimes honoured together.

It should be two independent sponsors, one as a proposer and one as a seconder, both abiding from two separate addresses.

Individuals who have been given a national honour (e.g. an MBE for services to Haslemere) are not usually considered for a Haslemere Volunteer award.
